

**Sightseeing tour to Jacob Levy Moreno's places of work in Vienna  
(on foot and by public transport)  
led by Sabine Kern und Markus Steidl**

10:15 Meeting Point: Maysedergasse 2, 1010 Vienna

Unveiling of the commemorative plaque, visit to the former premises of the "**Impromptu Theatre**"

11:00 – 11:45

Walk to Schwedenplatz; we pass St. Stephen's Cathedral, the most important Catholic church in Vienna, the City Temple, the Main Synagogue and the Greek Orthodox Church of the Holy Trinity. Take tram line 2 to **Moreno's first residential building** in Vienna.

11:45 – 12:15

Walk through **Vienna's Augarten**. This is seen as the place of origin of psychodrama therapy. By observing children at play, Moreno realized that spontaneous role-playing can be used to process what has been experienced.

12:15 – 12:30

A footbridge over the Danube Canal leads us to Haus Rossau, a residential building for senior citizens, in whose inner courtyard the **oldest Jewish cemetery in Vienna** is hidden, which we pay a visit.

12:30 – 12:45

In front of Sigmund **Freud's former practice at Berggasse 19**, we deal with Moreno's relationship to psychoanalysis.

12:45 – 14:00

Take tram line D to Karlsplatz. By the way, we can take a look at the magnificent buildings of Vienna's Ringstrasse. In a Viennese café, where Jacob Levy Moreno may have discussed with his companions from art and culture, the first part of our sightseeing tour comes to an end.

*The tour can now be completed or continued by taking part in the trip to the urn tomb of Moreno.*

14:40 – 16:00

Ride on tram line 71 to the Central Cemetery 2nd gate. **Visit to the urn grave of J.L. Moreno and the memorial plaque in memory of Marianne Lörnitzo, Beatrice Beecher, Helen Hall Jennings, Florence Bridge-Moreno and Zerka Toeman-Moreno.**

16:00 – 17:00

Rest at **Concordia Schössl**, a unique café-restaurant with a special flair.

17:30 End of the tour at Schwarzenbergplatz.
